The Historical Commission invites residents to submit nominations for the 2016 Annual Preservation and Restoration Awards. You can nominate yourself, a friend or a neighbor to celebrate efforts to preserve and restore historic properties that maintain our town's character and beauty. These properties can include residences, commercial buildings, or other structures whose preservation or restoration maintains or is faithful to the original design or style.

Eligible project categories are restoration, rehabilitation, adaptive re-use, neighborhood conservation and landscape preservation. Awards are presented in consideration of the following criteria:

- The historical and architectural integrity of the property preserved
- The exceptional quality of the project
- The extent to which the project contributed to the preservation of the property
- The impact on the preservation of the town's historic resources.
