What is LEED?

The Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System™ encourages sustainable green building and development practices through the creation and implementation of universally understood and accepted tools and performance criteria. LEED is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in <u>five</u> key areas of human and environmental health: <u>sustainable site development</u>, <u>water savings</u>, energy efficiency, materials selection and indoor environmental quality.
