

TRAFFIC STUDY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

1. Introductions – Chair Hayes provided welcome and introductory remarks.
2. Public Comments – Resident of Walnut Road requested no parking signage or installation of jersey barriers near 45 Walnut Road by landscaped island. There appears to be a neighbor dispute regarding parking on private property and blocking of roadway. The section of Walnut Road that the resident is seeking signage for is a private way. The town cannot install jersey barriers or signage on private way.
3. New Business
 - a. Resident Parking only Ross/Hillside & Upland – discussion and any action on this item has been continued to the August meeting.
 - b. Traffic flows & plans around Hadley/Blaney St- presentation was made regarding proposed traffic flow near Hadley School and neighborhood to address additional school traffic. Reddington Street two-way traffic pattern has been temporarily changed to a one-way traffic pattern in the northerly direction from Humphrey Street toward Banks Road. New signage and barricades will be installed in time for the start of the new school year in August.
 - c. Beach parking-
 - d. 460 Humphrey handicap parking- employee of a business, located at 460 Humphrey requested on street handicap parking space. The committee did not approve of the request due to the business having a parking lot and the ability to accommodate staff parking.
